## 3. SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

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### 3.1. Event Regulations

The Event organiser agrees the Racewars event will be held under the permit which is issued in compliance with the rules and regulations of the Australian National Drag Racing Association Limited (ANDRA) and any further regulations or bulletins which may be issued.

ANDRA Permit No. **XXX**

This event will include the following competitions and activities:

- Drag Racing
- Roll Racing



- Skid Row
- Static Show n Shine

This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with the ANDRA COVID-19 Pathway and Return to the Track approved event and venue plan as approved by ANDRA.

ANDRA insurances to cover competitors and event officials. Personal Accident Insurance is available automatically to all permanent ANDRA licence holders, including the Single Event Licence, at a Category Two level. For more information please see pages 39 – 44 of the [2020/2021 ANDRA Rulebook](#).

This event shall only be abandoned or cancelled in the case of force majeure under a decision of the Race Meeting Director and in accordance with ANDRA Rulebook.

Any protest or appeal of any result, decision or debate on the interpretation of the rules and regulations of shall be attended by the Meeting Director in conjunction with ANDRA personnel present on the day.

### 3.2. Alcohol, Drugs and other Substances

Any holder of a ‘Competition’, ‘Crew’ or ‘Officials’ credential (or equivalent credential issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the ANDRA substance abuse policy as published on the ANDRA website ([https://www.andra.com.au/wp-content/uploads/2018/12/15-20180920\\_ANDRA-Substance-Abuse-Policy-v2.3.pdf](https://www.andra.com.au/wp-content/uploads/2018/12/15-20180920_ANDRA-Substance-Abuse-Policy-v2.3.pdf))

Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day.

Accordingly, any holder of a ‘Competition’, ‘Crew’ or ‘Officials’ credential (or equivalent credential issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol in accordance with the ANDRA substance abuse policy.

The organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with the standing ANDRA rulebook and/or event terms and conditions.



Competitors under 18 years of age must have their entry counter signed/consented to by a parent/guardian.

#### 4.2. Drag Racing Competition Licence

Each drag racing entrant will require the applicable ANDRA licence dependant on the vehicle classification.

An ANDRA divisional day licence for each applicable entrant will be provided at the event. ANDRA divisional day licence cost is included in your entry fee. Each competitor/driver must sign and agree to the terms of ANDRA to be issued a licence.

A competitor/driver that holds an existing ANDRA Licence applicable to the event will not be required to obtain a competition Licence at the event. ## 5. CODE OF CONDUCT

## 6. ENTRANT CATEGORIES

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Vehicles will be classed in the following categories upon entry. Each classification has different event activity permissions and requirements.

### 6.1. Kebabs and Cars

Entrants who select this category are provided with a static access pass for the driver and vehicle only. Entrants can purchase an additional pass to participate in the Skid Row activity.

To participate in Skid Row the entrant and vehicle will need to comply with the applicable current ANDRA rulebook and any additional requirements as outlined in these supplementary regulations.

### 6.2. Drag Racing

Entrants who select this category are provided with a competition pass for the driver and vehicle. Entrants will need to comply with the ANDRA regulations and any additional requirements as outlined in these supplementary regulations

Drag Racing entrants can also purchase the Platinum Pass Upgrade and/or the Cash Days Buy In.

A summary of classes within the Drag Racing category are;

#### 6.2.1. True Street

Defined as registered vehicles with proof of current registration with street legal modifications.

Class requirements and restrictions:

- Headlights and brake lights must exist and be operational at all times
- No tow cars, exceptions will be made for breakages
- Any year vehicle is allowed. Aftermarket lightweight components are limited to bonnet and boot lid. Quarter panels must remain as originally manufactured. No body parts may be removed during



competition.

- All cars must retain complete stock chassis, firewall, and frame rails. Aftermarket k-member permitted.
- All cars must utilize stock style front & rear suspension. Aftermarket front control arms, rear control arms, and sub-frame connectors are permitted. Any aftermarket rear ends, or other suspension components must bolt into factory locations.
- Stock style dashboard and full interior is required except for parts removed to fit safety equipment. Aftermarket seats, gauges, and interior are permitted.
- Mufflers & full length "legal" exhaust systems are required for all vehicles.
- Two-steps, data loggers, aftermarket ECU's, and engine management systems are permitted.
- Aftermarket axles, ring and pinions, final drive, spools, and differentials are permitted.
- Manual or Auto transmissions are permitted. Vehicles must retain the OEM transmission as equipped from the manufacturer where possible. Aftermarket transmission swaps are permitted in this class with prior approval. Transbrakes, Air Shifters, strain gauge, and sequential transmissions are prohibited.
- Only commercially available pump fuel is allowed. Methanol or "Race Fuels" are prohibited.
- Limited to a 17" or larger diameter wheel and street tyre unless a smaller size was fitted from factory.
- No restrictions except for modifications that do not fit the spirit of this class.

### 6.2.2. Sportsman

Defined as a Hypercar or highly modified vehicles.

Class requirements and restrictions:

- Vehicles do not have to be street legal or registered.
- Vehicles do have to present so that they "could" be reasonably driven on the street.
- Headlights and brake lights must exist and be operational (one of each may be removed during competition for any reason after passing tech).
- Functional water pump, alternator and radiator, Internal Combustion Engines only, electric vehicles exempt.
- No tow cars, exceptions will be made for breakages
- Any year vehicle is allowed. Lightweight components are limited to bonnet, front fenders, boot lid, hatches, doors, sunroofs/t-tops/targa tops, wings, ground effects, and bumpers only. One-piece front ends are not permitted unless factory.
- All cars must retain complete stock chassis, firewall, and frame rails. Notching of chassis for clearance is permitted. Aftermarket "K" members are permitted.
- All cars must utilize stock style front suspension. Aftermarket front control arms, rear control arms, and sub-frame connectors are permitted.
- Stock style dashboard and full interior from front seats forward is required. Aftermarket seats, gauges, and interior are permitted.
- Muffler(s) are required unless vehicle is turbocharged. Exhaust may exit anywhere the vehicle whilst following the requirement as stated in the current ANDRA rulebook
- Two-steps, data loggers, aftermarket ECU's, and engine management systems are permitted.
- Aftermarket axles, ring and pinions, final drive, spools, and differentials are permitted.
- Manual or Auto transmissions are permitted. Any style automatic transmission is permitted. Transbrakes are permitted.
- Any type of Ethanol or pump fuel allowed. The use of Methanol is prohibited.
- Drag Radials no larger than a 275.
- Vehicles equipped with a factory tyre sizes larger than a 275 may elect to use DOT legal tyres including radials of an equivalent size.
- Vehicles with 6 cylinders or less may run dual power adders, 8 cylinder and up is limited to single power adders (twin turbos are ok).
- Vehicles may run battery power adders for hybrid and some hypercars/exotics





### 6.2.3. Open Class

Defined as any type chassis, no dragsters or altered.

Class requirements and restrictions:

- Any year vehicle is allowed
- Any type chassis is permitted. No dragsters or altered.
- Wheelie bars are prohibited for all vehicles except FWD.
- OEM glass or lexan/composite is permitted.
- Interior: no restrictions
- Exhaust: no restrictions
- Electronics: no restrictions
- Driveline: no restrictions
- Transmission: no restrictions
- Fuel: no restrictions
- Tyres: no restrictions
- Engine: no restrictions
- Power Adder: no restrictions
- Engine diaper or catch pan is required

## 7. COMPETITION VEHICLES

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### 7.1. General Requirements

Drag Racing entrants must comply with the requirements of the current ANDRA rulebook, refer to Appendix B, C and D

The driver must be the Entrant registered with the vehicle.

### 7.2. Vehicles Licencing and Tech Classifications

Vehicles will be classed using ANDRA regulations. Vehicles which are defined by the below will be subject to the ANDRA Off Street Meet vehicle and driver requirements as per Appendix C ([https://www.andra.com.au/wp-content/uploads/2021/10/ANDRA-Off-Street-Meet-Vehicle-Driver-Rider-Requirements\\_1320ft\\_v8.pdf](https://www.andra.com.au/wp-content/uploads/2021/10/ANDRA-Off-Street-Meet-Vehicle-Driver-Rider-Requirements_1320ft_v8.pdf))

- Unmodified\* Sedan based vehicles without factory fitted OEM four-wheel disc brakes and/or OEM driver's airbag
- Unmodified\* Modern Street Cars with factory fitted OEM four-wheel disc brakes and OEM driver's airbags.
- \*Unmodified: A car with no modifications to the rear floor, rear wheel wells or boot floor, with a fixed Steel roof.
- Supercars & Hypercars in unmodified OEM certified guise may be granted an exemption from the fitment of additional safety features provided subject to prior joint approval by ANDRA Stewards

Vehicles outside these definitions will be subject to the general ANDRA class regulations as per Appendix B, C and D

### 7.3. Accreditation

Vehicles must display the Racewars decal kit including windscreen banner ((if provided) and entrant numbers as per the instruction guideline which will be supplied with the decal kit

If Racewars license plate covers are purchased by the entrant these may only be displayed on the competing vehicle during the event and must be removed before the vehicle is driven on public roads.



#### 7.4. Fire Extinguishers

A handheld fire extinguisher (minimum 1kg ABE extinguisher) must be fitted to each vehicle with a bracket fit for purpose. Fire suppression systems are accepted and a minimum 5lbs capacity is required for vehicles running 8.000 and faster, unless specified otherwise by ANDRA Class regulations.

#### 7.5. Roll Cages

Some vehicles are required to have roll cages as per ANDRA regulations as per Appendix B, C and D.

As per the ANDRA regulations noted in Appendix B, C and D, some vehicles require roll cages.

For vehicles with roll cages built to Motorsport Australia specifications refer to 4.13 within the ANDRA rulebook for classification reference.

#### 7.6. Parachutes

Vehicles are required to have parachutes as per ANDRA regulations as per Appendix B, C and D.

As per the ANDRA regulations noted in Appendix B, C and D, some vehicles require parachutes.

#### 7.7. Fuel

##### 7.7.1. Fuel Storage:

It is not permitted to store fuel at Perth Motorplex. This includes the storage of fuel within or on trucks / transporters that are parked in the designated truck / transporter parking areas at the venue. Fuel must be removed from site when competitors leave the venue each day.

##### 7.7.2. Refuelling:

Cars participating in driving activities will be able to take their fuel to the venue for use during the competitions. Competitors/pit crew must be familiar with the location of the nearest fire extinguisher station.

No smoking and no children permitted in any refuel area.

##### 7.7.3. Fuel Suppliers:

Speciality fuels can be purchased directly from local distributors. It is recommended that you make contact directly with the distributors to pre-order your fuel, as they cannot guarantee stock will be available on the day without pre-ordering.

## 8. SCRUTINEERING

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### 8.1. Location

Registration and Scrutineering is held at Perth Motorplex. Access will be off Anketell Drive. Follow the signs and the direction from the Racewars officials.

See the Scrutineering map available in the Entrant Event Guide.

## 9. DRIVERS

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### 9.1. General Driving Event Regulations – Drivers

#### 9.1.1. Driver Accreditation

Entrants participating in driving events are requested to sign the ANDRA Risk statement prior to their participation.

Once the ANDRA Risk statement has been completed and witnessed by a Racewars official will provide the Driver with a driver wristband.

This wristband must remain fitted for the duration of the event or for the duration of their participation as a driver.

#### 9.1.2. Driver Briefing

All entrants participating in driving events must attend any applicable briefings or other meeting as requested by Racewars. Failure to attend will result in the competitor being prohibited from competing.

#### 9.1.3. Driver Safety

Entrants participating in driving events must comply with the personal protective equipment as determined by the ANDRA regulations as per Appendix B, C and D.

## 10. PASSENGERS

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### 10.1. General Driving Event Regulations - Passengers

Passengers are permitted for eligible driving events only, at the officials' discretion. All passengers will be required to sign the ANDRA Risk Statement prior to their participation.

Driving events eligible for passengers are;

- Skid row
- Grudge Runs

A maximum of one (1) passenger is permitted in the entrant vehicle at any one time whilst participating in the driving event.

#### 10.1.1. Passenger Accreditation

Once the ANDRA Risk Statement has been completed and witnessed by a Racewars official will provide the passenger with a passenger wristband.

This wristband must remain fitted for the duration of the event or for the duration of their participation as a passenger.

The passenger wristband will permit the passenger to participate in any driving event where passengers are permitted.

Existing entrants are not required to wear a passenger wristband as all entrants have completed the ANDRA Risk Statement for the event.

#### 10.1.2. Passenger Safety

Passengers will be required to follow the same safety requirements as the entrant/competitor. Therefore, if they are participating in a competition that requires a fire suit, automotive helmet etc. they must meet these requirements. Refer to Appendix F



## 11. Skid Row

The skid row activity is held over Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> of February at Perth Motorplex when drag racing and roll racing competitions are active.

### 11.1. Safety for Drivers and Approved Passengers

Skid Row is not a competition activity.

- Driver and Passenger must use a seatbelt or harness
- Driver and passenger must wear a helmet
- Drivers and passengers must not be under the influence of alcohol. Random Breath Testing will be conducted on drivers and passengers in accordance with ANDRA Alcohol Policy (please refer to Section 3.2 of this document)
- Drivers and Passengers detected, by officials (alcohol on breath or erratic behaviour), to have consumed alcohol will be removed from the queue and will risk disqualification from the competition. The Driver will be responsible for the actions and conduct of a passenger within the competition vehicle.

## 12. Drag Racing

The drag racing competitions will be conducted in accordance with the current ANDRA rule book, and these regulations.

All drag racing competitions will be held at Perth Motorplex.

The driver must be the Entrant registered with the vehicle.

### 12.1. Test and Tune

Test and tune for drag racing entrants will be held on Friday 25<sup>th</sup> of February between 1:00pm and 4:00pm

### 12.2. Drag Racing Competition

The drag racing is held over Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> of February.

The qualifying Top 16 progress – quickest ET

## 13. Roll Racing

### 13.1. Test and Tune

Test and tune for roll racing entrants will be held on Friday 25<sup>th</sup> of February between 4:00pm and 7:00pm

### 13.2. Roll Racing Competition

The roll racing 1520ft competition is held over Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> of February at Perth Motorplex.

The categories and competition formats are:

Competition Format	Classes
One (1) Qualifying Round – Top 16 Progress to Finals Finals – Straight Elimination	True Street
One (1) Qualifying Round – Top 16 Progress to Finals Finals – Straight Elimination	Sportsman
One (1) Qualifying Round – Top 16 Progress to Finals Finals – Straight Elimination	Open

Entrants are paired in the staging lanes. Entrants line up at the defined start line where officials will signal the start.

Entrants will have 60m to reach the target speed of 40-60km/h side by side. Entrants will be given a green light on the start line of the drag racing track starting the race.

Right lane sets the pace. There will be a breakout threshold set for all brackets except Outlaw. The breakout speed will be 15 km/h over the number one qualifier in each class.



Entrants will race the end of the track and the first through the beam at the end of the drag racing track will be deemed the winner the race.

Officials may trigger a red light manually if an entrant 'jumped' the start line.

An entrant can be deemed to have 'jumped' the start by accelerating into a racing speed prior to both vehicles crossing the start line on the drag strip.

Roll Racing track distance is 1520ft including the rolling start area.

Top 16 finalists will be determined by the quickest ET set in qualifying.
